





- Business Interruption
 - Loss of services
 - Media concerns
 - Additional concerns about public safety
 - Every building can have a unique situation







- Computer Systems & Servers
 - Data Recovery
 - Keeping servers online
 - Often operates phone system
 - Need to have "A" team IT player lined up ahead of time







- Life Safety Systems
 - Fire detection
 - Fire suppression
 - Alarm systems
 - Emergency lighting
 - Emergency exits
 - Elevators









- Electrical Systems
 - Switch gears
 - Transformers
 - OEM control panels
 - Megger testing







- Power
 - Rarely sufficient power distribution
 - Distribution power calculations
 - Generators easy to find
 - 120, 208, 240, 480 single phase, 3 phase



 Distribution system, complicated, can be hard to find, just as important as the generator





- HVAC
 - Duct work
 - Chillers, pumps, motors
 - Boilers, air handlers
 - Combined systems









- Asbestos and Lead Assessment
- Do your buildings have an assessment
- Nearly every building material has a risk of being hazardous
- Need on-site environmental assessor if prior assessment is not

available

- Abatement costs
- Huge liability if building is

contaminated









- Building Stabilization
 - Control the environment
 - Prevent secondary damage
 - Prevent contamination of the building especially LEED certified buildings
 - Isolate affected areas









- Emergency relocation
 - Setup temporary office(s)
 - Prioritize computers and documents
 - Pack out remaining contents
 - Storage






