If an instructor wants a course pack they have to do all the work with a legitimate course pack company who will get the copyrights. If an instructor publishes a book or lab manual they have to go thru a publisher and they will get paid by the publisher never the college. We do have one instructor that wrote her own book and she goes thru a publisher.</p> <p>(Note: We discourage course packs as the material cannot be sold back to the bookstore by the students and sold a used. Course packs usually require copyright contracts that can only be produced for a set number of copies.)</p>			No
